

The Suisun Marsh Natural History Association is a non-profit 501(c)3 membership organization. Incorporated in 1977, the Association's Suisun Wildlife Center has for 40 years cared for and released back to the wild injured and orphaned wildlife in Solano County, many affected by human activity.

A committed staff of volunteers, trained and ready to care for rescued wildlife, gives birds and animals the best care possible. Since opening, over 200 species of birds, mammals, and reptiles have been treated; and we have released almost 17,000 back to the wild!

Environmental Education

The Environmental Education program offers wildlife and natural history shows and field trips to private and public schools and groups.

They focus on native California wildlife, the Suisun Marsh, and many other natural history subjects. Education has been a major part of the Association's efforts, and over 300,000 children and adults have participated in the program.
